

# CTK CHEERLEADING “FAQS”

**1. When are practices?**

One day per week (Monday - Thursday)

Games can be on Friday Nights, Saturdays 9am – 6pm or Sunday’ s after 12 noon (2 – 6)

**2. What grades can participate?**

Kindergarten – 8<sup>th</sup> Grade

**3. Can I request a day for practice and or games?**

Put down what day is not good. There are no guarantees.

(If we cannot accommodate you, we will offer you a refund)

**4. Can I request a coach?**

Only if you are willing to be an assistant or a coach will you be guaranteed a coach. Otherwise put down your request but no there are no guarantees.

**5. Can siblings be put together?**

Only if they have similar abilities and are within 1 – 2 grades of each other.

**6. How are the teams broken up?**

Grades: K – 2, 3 – 5 & 6 – 8.

**7. What is the cost?**

\$100 first child, \$90 second child, \$60 third child, \$40 fourth child

A maximum of \$300 per family is charged for all sports.

**8. How long is the season?**

The season runs from mid- /end October until March

**9. When will I get a phone call?**

Some time from the middle to the end of October.

**10. Can a High School Student get community service hours?**

Yes Middle School and High School students can get credit for them.

**11. Does it conflict with Soccer or basketball ?**

No, most girls participate in more than one sport.

**12. When do I pick up uniforms?**

November (on a Saturday in the morning)

**13. Is there any additional charge for uniforms?**

Yes and there is a deposit for part of the uniform that gets refunded to you.

**14. Can I get my deposit back?**

Yes when you return the uniform.

**15. Will there be another registration?**

Yes in August and September.

Late registrations will be accepted until November 1<sup>st</sup>.

**16. Can friends be put together?**

Yes as long as they are in the same grade and the moms are willing to help.

**19. Where are the Practices and Games held?**

Schools within the Commack district and or the CTK GYM.

**20. Who do they cheer for?**

Christ the King Basketball Teams. We do not travel to other districts. We only do Home Games.

**21. Is there a competition team? Do they go to competitions?**

There is a cheerleading showcase in March (first Sunday) in Nassau sponsored by the CYO for grades 3 & 4 and higher. All participants receive a trophy for their performance.

**22. Is there a tryout for a team?**

No, there are no tryouts Teams are based more on a Grade Level, Day availability and the coaches.

**23. Is the Cheerleader required to go to the practices/games or showcases?**

No this is a fun, volunteer organization.

**24. How long are the practices and games?**

Most practices are for grades K – 6 are one hour to one and a half hour. They start and end on time. The 6 – 8 team is 1 ½ - 2 hours. This may vary depending on the gym and coaches availability.

**25. Are there any other fees/charges?**

In addition to the registration fee, there is a Parent-Participation fee, a uniform fee and a uniform deposit fee.

**26. What is the parent participation fee?**

\$25. This will be returned at the end of the season. If the Parent Volunteers to help out in any capacity (Uniform helpers, team mom, bathroom helpers & hall Monitors) 5 – 10 hours during the season.

**27. What is the uniform deposit fee?**

\$25 this is returned when the uniform is returned at the end of The season (poms/skirt/tops)

**28. What is the uniform? Are there additional items to purchase?**

For the younger teams, the uniform is a skirt, sweatshirt, socks and poms. For the older teams a uniform (sleeveless) top is provided. Additional items that can be purchased are sweatpants, t-shirts, shorts and bags. You will be required to purchase inexpensive ked' s type sneakers and a pair of lollipops (briefs) in Royal Blue/Navy to be worn under the skirts.
